In Memoriam

TED AVERY CASHION MAY, 2 1959 - JUNE 18, 2023



Ted Avery Cashion, 64, of Raleigh, NC, passed away on June 18, 2023, following a courageous battle with cancer. Ted was born in Sanford, NC, to the late Jimmie Lee Cashion and Betty Ann Saunders Cashion. He spent a large portion of his childhood in New Bern, NC, and after graduating from East Carolina University with a BS degree, he spent his career with NCDENR, working in Water Quality as an Inspector/Supervisor, with several years also in Hazardous Waste Management. Ted was a faithful member of Westover UMC, serving in many roles. He was a generous, quiet, gentle, but powerful witness, sharing his deep faith in God through his compassion for others. His heart was serving in prison ministry, especially with those on Death Row. He faithfully served on Kairos teams starting in 1995 sharing his love of Christ with the residents of Central Prison in any needed role, whether a runner delivering meals or the program leader. Ted was a founding member of Short Journey, a prison ministry created to share the Gospel with those on Death Row. He also helped lead a weekly Bible Study with Death Row residents. Ted was responsible for helping many Montagnard families from Viet Nam reunite, settle, and become successful citizens in Raleigh. Because of his caring nature, they became members of his extended family.

Ted was a sports enthusiast coaching baseball and spending time as a "bird dog" scout for several professional baseball teams. He also enjoyed hockey with his wife Nancy, and hunting with friends.

Ted is survived by his loving wife of 28 years, Nancy Hendrix Cashion, brother Tim Cashion (Neva) of Washington, NC, nieces Brooke Flesher (Pat, son Thompson) of Broken Arrow, OK, and Nola Jones (Ryan) of Hookerton, NC, mother-in-law Polly Hendrix, sister-in-law Ann Vavro (Gary), and nephew Christopher Winstead (son Connor). He is also survived by special "Cashion Cousins" Jackie, Jill, Jan, Jeff, and Julia and their spouses and families. In addition, he is survived by his large extended family of Montagnards and friends.

The family would like to thank Ted's doctors, nurses, and other medical professionals and staff for their dedicated, compassionate care. We will be forever grateful.
